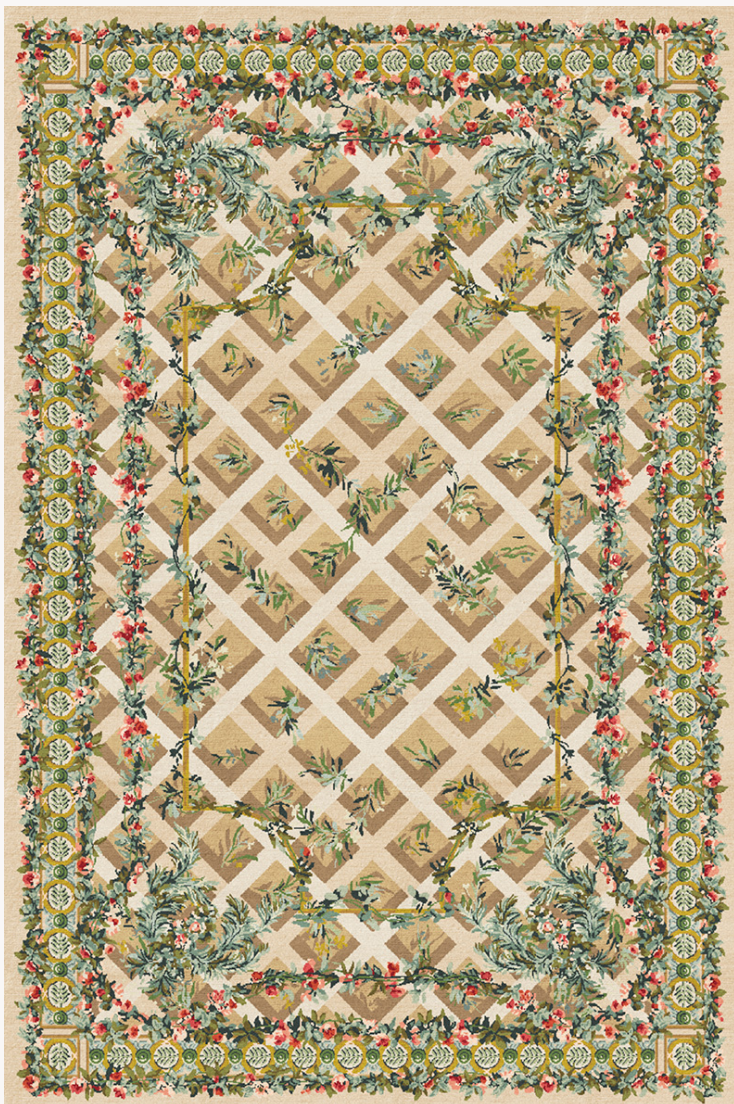


## BT137001 CHENONCEAU
