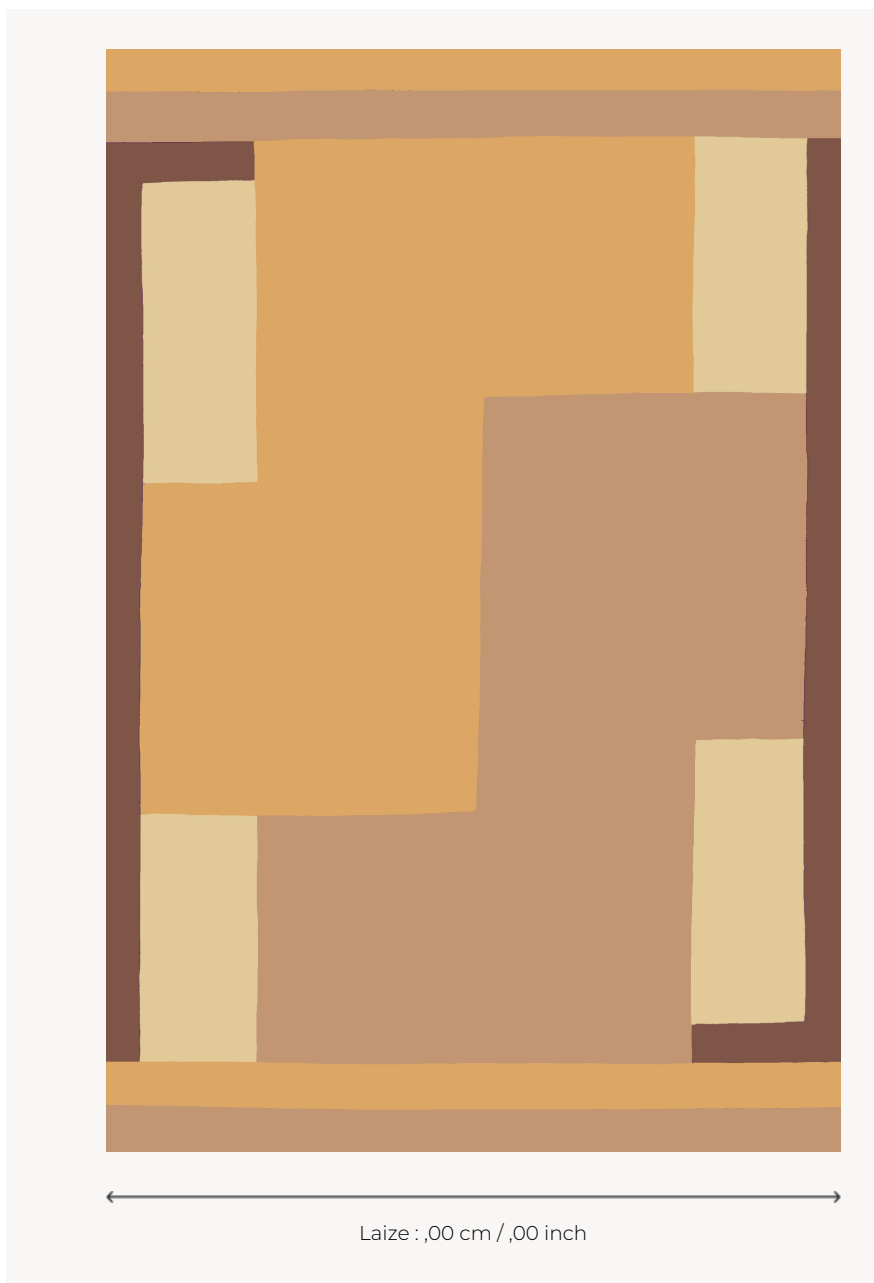


# FT421002 MALMO
