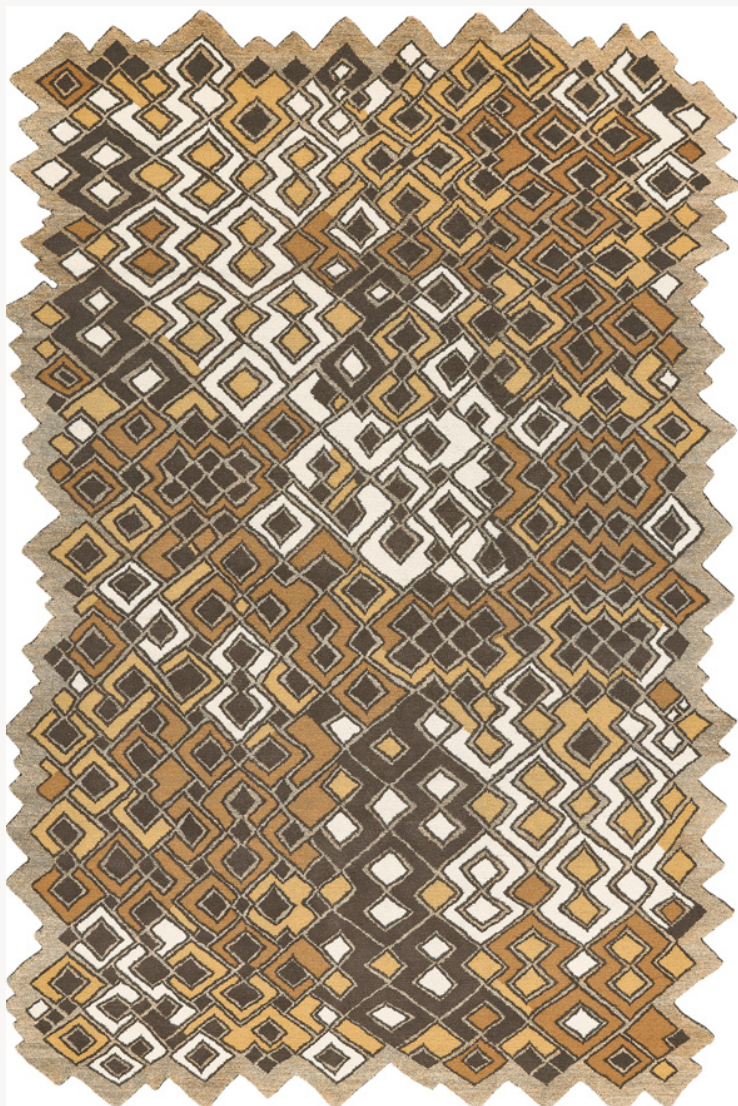


## FT483001 KARAKOUM
