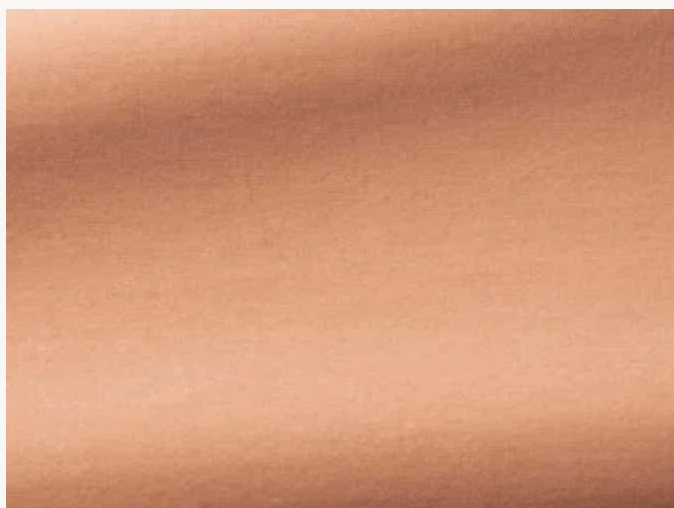




F3211024 MEDIUM

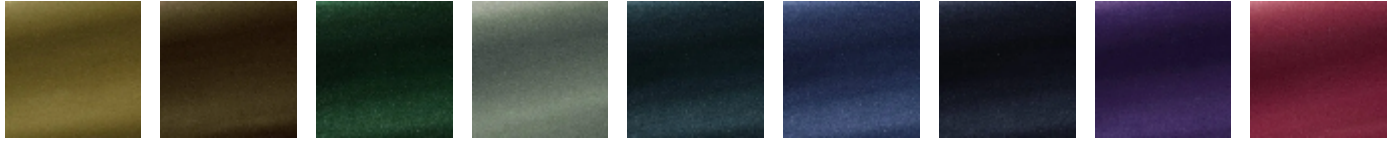
