

## F3378001 FONTAINE ET ANIMAUX

Christian Astuguevieille has taken a new look at this emblematic fabric designed by Jean-Baptiste Huet, which is conserved in our archives. It was printed using the copperplate technique at the Oberkampf manufactory in Jouy-en-Josas, circa 1803. The scale of the design has been modified, and the original latticework in the background has been replaced with white, which highlights the details on this fabric. The fabric has been recolored by the artist. The Neoclassical motif is thus enhanced by a contemporary approach.
