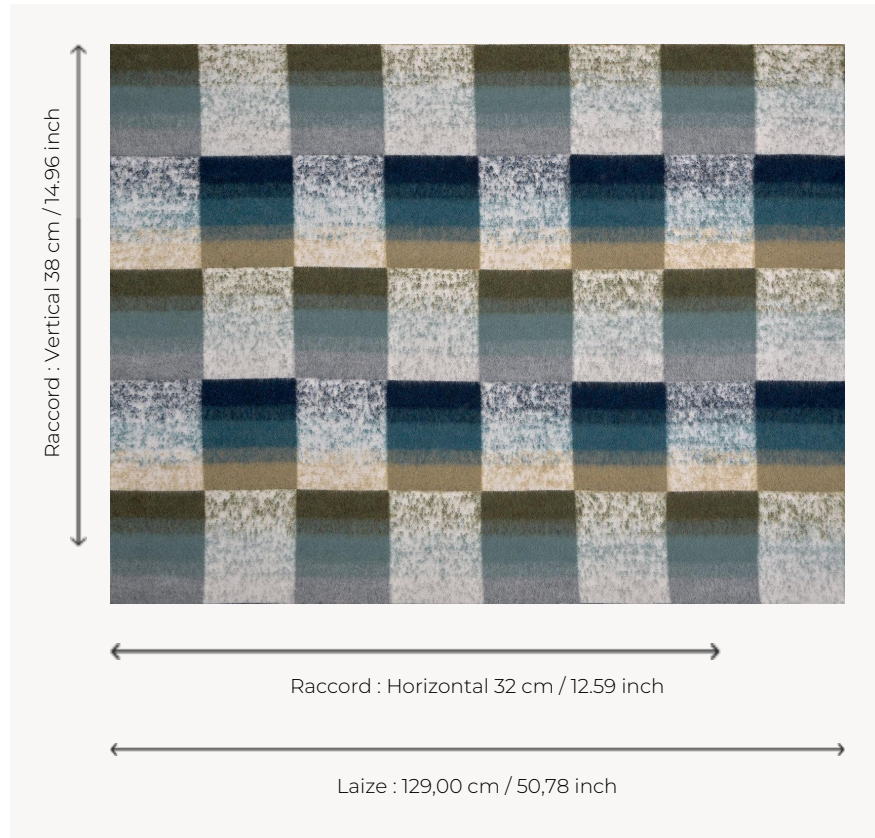




F4036003 BERGEN

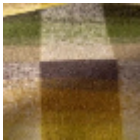
