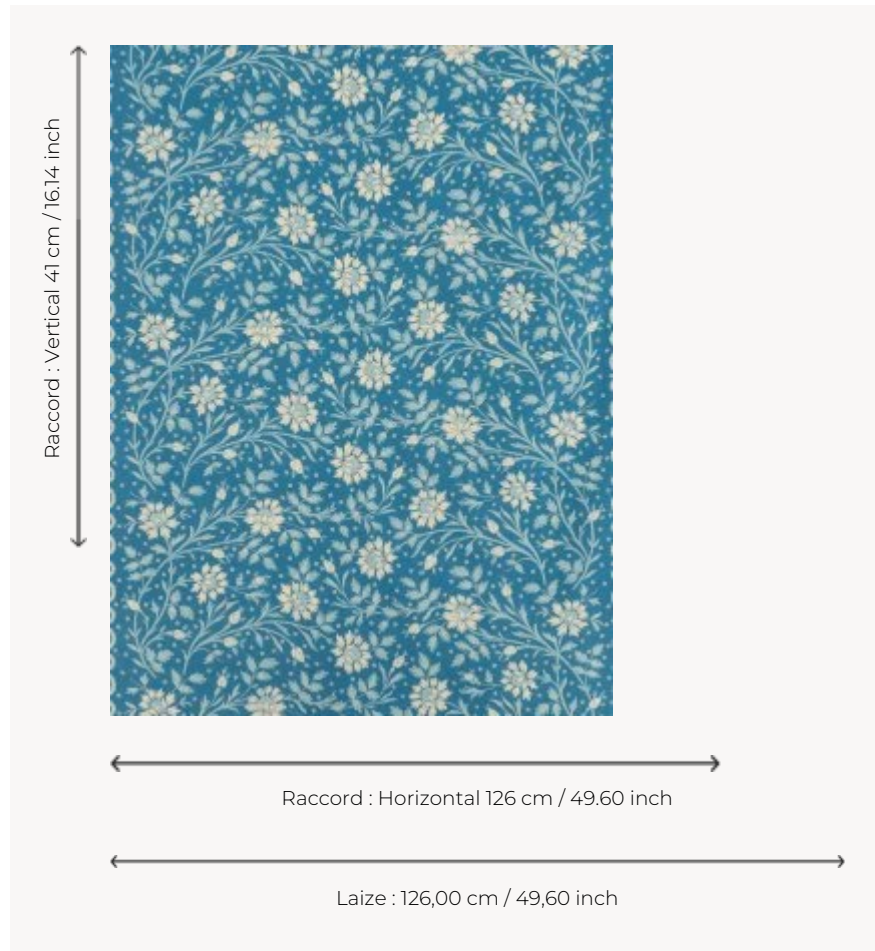


## L3578001 BATIK

Major classic from the House and printed on cotton, BATIK reproduces a textile from the beginning of the 20th century. Originally used for clothing and ceremonies, the batik print is done with a tool called "canting". This tool is used to apply wax on the parts of the fabric to be left blank before dying to create a motif.

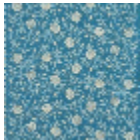
