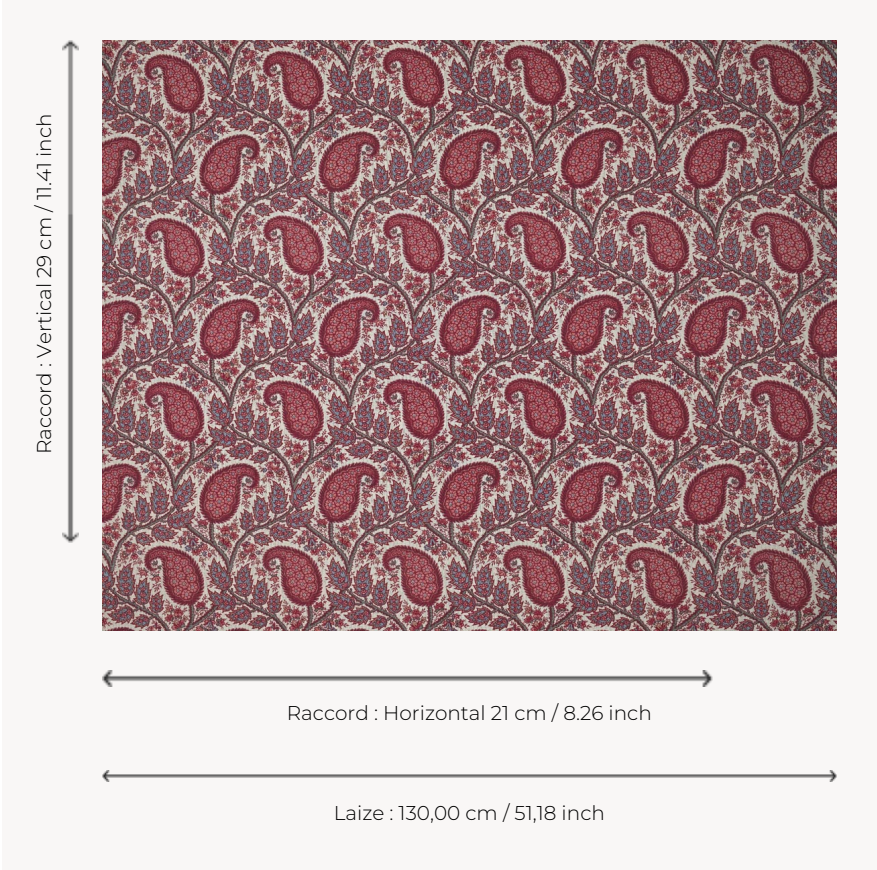


# T0108002 PHYSIC
