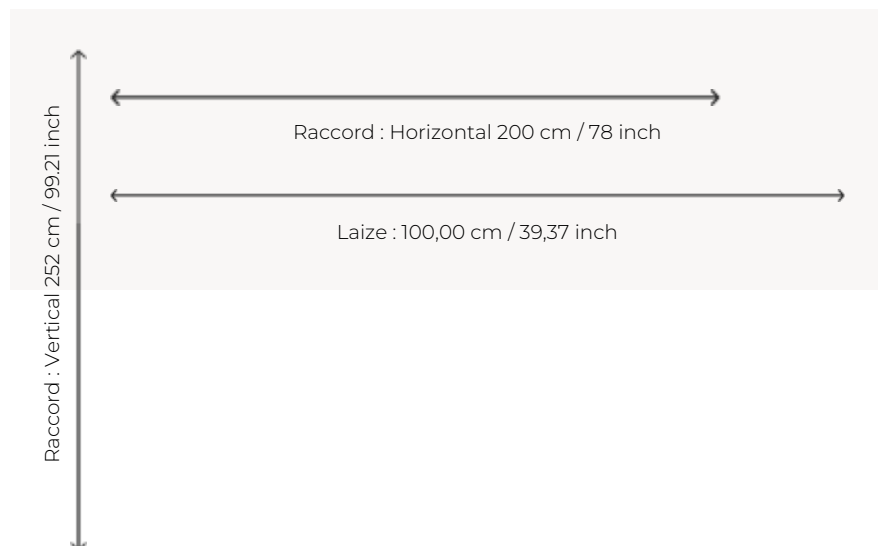



# FP424666 NUBEM

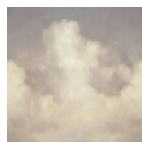
