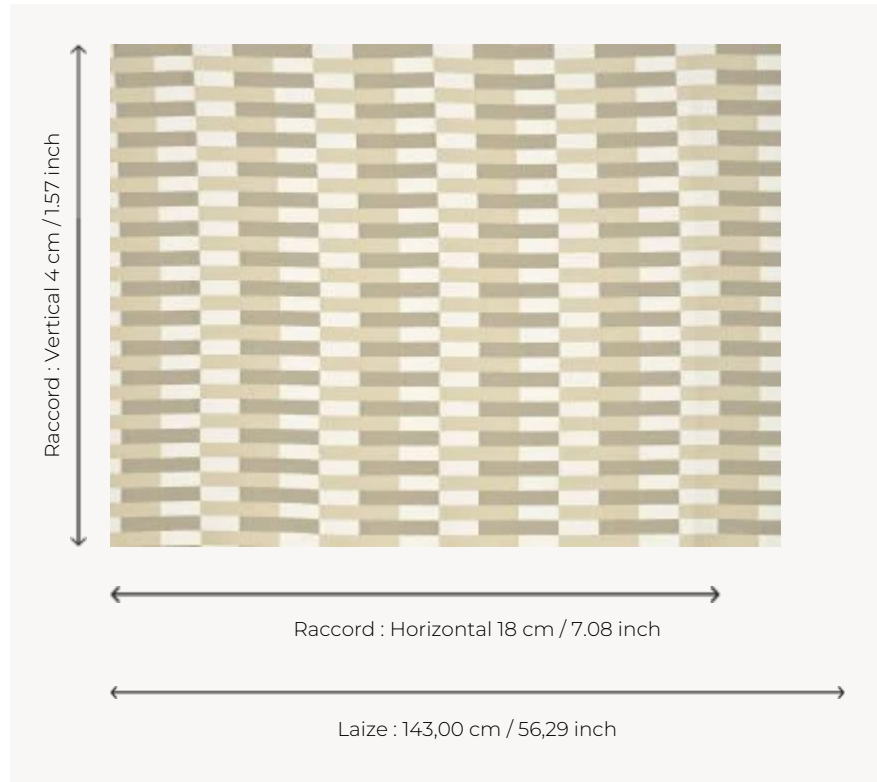


F3710001 MAPUTO
