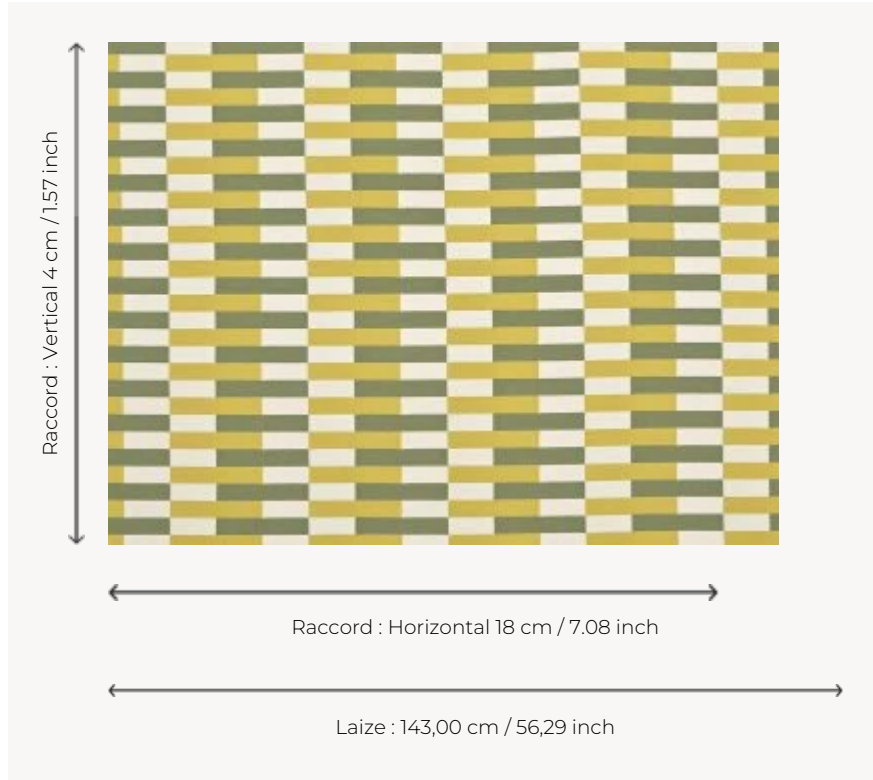



# F3710002 MAPUTO
