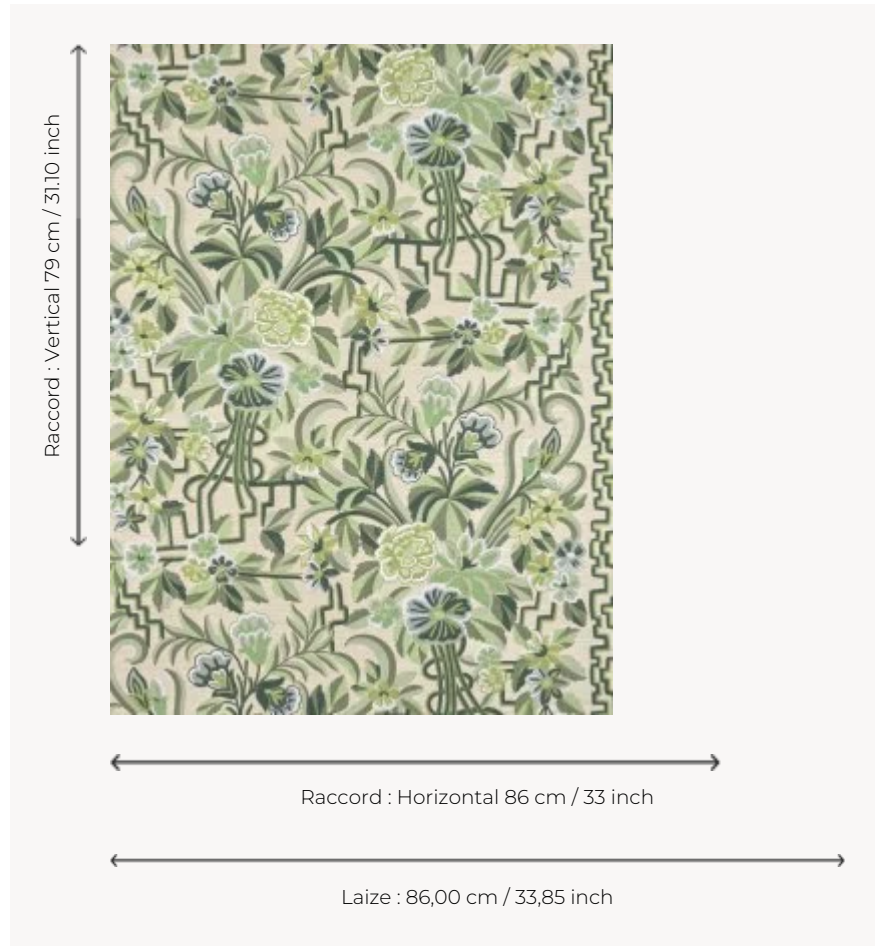


FP043002 HANA

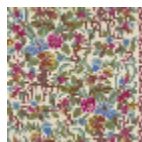
